Resident Advisory Committee Meeting Agenda

- 1. Roll Call
- 2. Follow-up discussions from last meeting:
 - a. Remind CSID regarding the following items:
 - This meeting is to be run by the landowner committee and not CSID.
 - We have not received any information from CSID as to why they want to remove the trees.
 - The goal of the Landowner committee is to work with the Coral Springs
 Improvement District (CSID) to formulate a plan to mitigate the risk of flooding
 and minimize erosion, while considering the impact to existing trees and
 wildlife habitats.
 - b. Discuss the following:
 - The excellent job CSID is currently doing to prevent flooding.
 - How the committee will handle the fact that CSID has been unwilling or unable to provide any documentation regarding why the decision has been made to remove the trees.
 - How the committee will we handle the fact that CSID has not performed any
 due diligence or analysis regarding the impact to the environment or wildlife
 when they made the decision to remove the trees.
 - The lack of information is greatly impacting the committee's ability to do analysis on the necessity to remove the trees.
- 3. Request that CSID share with the committee the reasons why they came up with the decision to remove all the trees without analysis.
- 4. CSID will:

- a. Provide evidence that concludes that there is absolutely no other way to mitigate the flood risk without removing all the trees.
- b. Provide concrete evidence that removal of the trees will solve the potential, yet unlikely, event of flooding.
- 5. The Landowner committee will begin the process of documenting the conclusions they have come up with based on the evidence provided.
