THIS ADDENDUM SHALL MODIFY AND BECOME A PART OF THE ORIGINAL ITB DOCUMENT. THE FOLLOWING CLARIFICATIONS, CHANGES, ADDITIONS, AND/OR DELETIONS ARE HEREBY MADE PART OF THE CONTRACT DOCUMENTS FOR ITB 2023-02 WATER TREATMENT PLANT BULK CHEMICALS

TO ALL PROSPECTIVE BIDDERS

1. Clarification – Schedule C; Scope of Services; 1. Delivery Requirements

The Supplier (also referred to as “Contractor”) shall be responsible for pumping all bulk deliveries into the storage tanks at the delivery sites (Water Treatment Plant and Wastewater Treatment Facility) located at 10300 NW 11th Manor, Coral Springs, FL 33071 and shall provide all necessary hoses, fittings, pumps, etc. required to safely and efficiently off load the chemicals into designated storage tanks.

2. Clarification – Schedule C; Scope of Services; 3.2 Ammonium Sulfate 40%; Special Delivery Requirements

Deliveries can be made via totes however it must be pumped by contractor from their totes into Coral Springs Improvement District Water Treatment Plant storage tank.

3. Clarification – Schedule C; Scope of Services; 3.5 Sodium Hydroxide (Caustic Soda); Special Delivery Requirements

Product shall be pumped into the bulk tanks with an electric pump; use of pressurized air to offload is not acceptable due to danger of overfilling and damage to the Water Treatment Plant tanks.

4. Clarification – Schedule C; Scope of Services; 3.6 Liquid Sulfuric Acid (93%); Special Delivery Requirements

The supplier will be required to transport the bulk shipments to the site Water Treatment Plant and unload the product into a 4000-gallon storage tank with a cam-lock fitting that is provided by the DISTRICT.

5. Addition – Schedule C; Scope of Services; 3.3 Calcium Hypochlorite (HTH)

3.3.1. Minimum Delivery: 400 lbs. (4 ~~drums~~ buckets, weighing 100 lbs. each)

3.3.2. Estimated Annual Usage: 1,000 lbs. (10 ~~drums~~ buckets, weighing 100 lbs. each)

6. Question from Halle Whitney – Shrieve Chemical

- q. Can you please tell me the plant locations for the deliveries of ammonium sulfate, caustic soda, and sulfuric acid?
- a. Please see clarifications above on the Scope of Services.

7. Question from Tom Rebik – Harn R/O Systems Inc.

- q. I just discovered your ITB this morning. We have been supplying CSID with cartridge filters for many years and I feel the Avista brand of antiscalant and membrane cleaners would serve CSID very well. If we are able to bid still, would this bid accept alternates from the brand names listed?
- a. Unless you can provide what is specified in the scope of work, we are not interested in any alternatives.

8. Question from Chris Burns – Shrieve Chemical

- q. Can you please confirm the **total gallons** of each delivery of 93% sulfuric acid? Full truck is ~3,200 gallons.
- a. Deliveries will be anywhere between 1,500 and 3,500 gallons. (or 3,200 max if that's all your truck can hold)

- q. Can you pls provide how many galls each load was [of sulfuric acid] for the last year? Thank you.
